

Kari Pulli is Nokia Fellow at Nokia Research Center in Palo Alto, CA, USA, where he heads a research team working on mobile imaging. He is also a Member of Nokia CEO's Technology Council. He joined Nokia in 1999, headed Nokia's graphics technology, research, and standardization, visited MIT 2004-06, then helped found NRC Palo Alto in 2006. He is an adjunct faculty at University of Oulu, has a PhD from University of Washington and an MBA from University of Oulu. Before Nokia Kari worked on graphics at Stanford University (on Digital Michelangelo Project), Alias|Wavefront, SGI, and Microsoft. He is in the editorial boards of "IEEE Computer Graphics & Applications" and "Computers and Graphics" and wrote a book on Mobile 3D Graphics, and has been active on mobile multimedia standardization at Khronos.
